Organizations also should feel free to nominate themselves when applicable. Nominated projects should have been completed within the past year (2023).

A brief description of these awards is listed below:

Teaching Excellence—for outstanding or innovative teaching of East Tennessee history, family history, or genealogy at any level, from grammar school through adult education.

History in the Media—in recognition of excellence in the promotion, preservation, or interpretation of history by an individual or organization related through writing, production, performance, websites, social media campaigns, or other.

Project Excellence—in recognition of a special project, such as a book or other publication; building preservation; or special programming (conference, heritage event, lecture series, other) produced by an individual or organization.

Community History Leadership—in recognition of excellence in community leadership, specifically in promoting the preservation, promotion, and/or interpretation of local East Tennessee history.

Lifetime Achievement—in recognition of an individual who, over the course of a lifetime, has made outstanding contributions to the preservation, promotion, or interpretation of East Tennessee history.

We hope you will consider making nominations on behalf of your friends or organization. If you represent a historical society, museum, or other organization, please share this invitation with your members and friends.

Recipients will be recognized at the ETHS Awards of Excellence event on Saturday, May 18, in Knoxville (location to be determined). More information on times and tickets will be available in early April.

- 3. Conclusion on the significance and impact of the person, organization, or project.

Also include:

- 1. If a publication is being nominated, submit a copy of that publication.
- 2. With all nominations, include copies of press releases, publicity, screen shots, brochures, photos, and other documentary materials pertaining to the project or person.
- 3. Please submit/identify one image representative of the person, organization, or project.
